Deaths caused by natural disasters in Europe only in 2017

€360 Bil.

Reported economic losses since 1980 due to weather and climate extreme events in the Union



322% Increase in the burnt area in 2017 (compared to 2008-16 average), representing **1.8%** of total forest mass in Europe






Types of hazard for which the UCPM was activated (overview 2014-2017, EU & worldwide)

Improved linkages with other EU instruments acting on disaster risk management



On a number of occasions assets were not available to respond to disasters. Why?


- Low incentives

Covered 58.82%




Burnt Areas mapped in EFFIS (*)



(*) The burnt areas mapped in EFFIS represent, on average, about 80% of the total area burned by wildfires, since only fires larger than 30 ha are mapped. The area burnt by fires smaller than 30 ha represent about 20% of the total burnt area in each country, but this area is not mapped in EFFIS.








